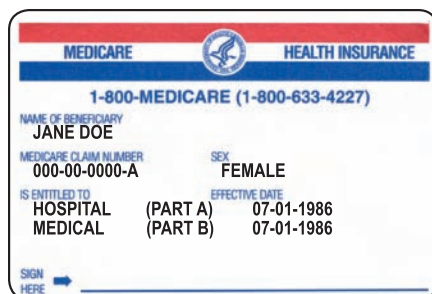

KyHealth Choices Card
